








Defining Assistive Technology (AT)

- FY'24 Total Invested in AT is \$852,079












Equipment and Modifications





Impact

- Our funded AT partners supported 109 individuals in FY'23
- Results of their efforts:
 - o 99% reported they increased their independence
 - 81% reported they experienced improved physical well-being
 - 95% reported they and their caregivers experienced improved emotional well-being

 - Collaboration with ESMW

- PLB and MoAT have both financially invested in the enhancement of the demonstration center at Paraquad
