## Recreation Council Vouchers (cont.)

#### After-School/Extended Day

This voucher assists school-age participants, ages 13-21, whose parents are working after-school or before school hours and need care for their loved one while working. In St. Louis City, the care extends to assist individuals who are attending a day program. Only available in St. Louis City and County.

18 Individuals Served in St. Louis County

#### **Summer Socialization**

This voucher assists school-age participants ages 13-21 during the summer months whose parents are working. Participants choose recreation programs and care as needed.

St Louis County residents only. 19 Individuals Served

## **Recreation Supports Vouchers**

Funds to Assist Participants Who Need Personal Care Assistance While Attending Community-Based Recreation Programs. An Example would Include Participation in Day Camps and Need Individualized Support in Order to Successfully Engage in the Program 5 Served

### Qualifying for Voucher Programs:

- \*Participants MUST Reside in St. Louis City, St. Louis County or St. Charles County
- \*Participants MUST Have a Verified Intellectual/Developmental Disability
- \*Some Voucher Programs Have Age Restrictions
- \*Must Fully Complete the Voucher Application
- \*The Recreation Supports Voucher, the Participant/Family Must Choose the Provider that They Know and Trust
- \*All Vouchers Have Participant Co-Pays




